<p><b>Although it is possible to take the German test and ECUS exam simultaneously in August, we recommend taking the test for German (level C1) at a prior date; this way, you'll be able to approach the other subjects (which are all tested in German) possessing high-level German skills, thus spending less time and effort for acquiring knowledge from the beginning.</b></p>		
<p><b>Total ca. 20 lessons per week (depending on the combination of subjects)</b>            * We reserve the right to reduce the number of lessons or charge the subject-specific private lesson rate for individual lessons should 5 or less students be enrolled in these subjects. (With 5 or fewer students, we need fewer lessons for an optimal exam preparation than with large classes).</p>
