- Good knowledge of French and English

- Enjoyment of and interest in abstract thinking as well as diligence and discipline

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT FOR THE FEDERAL MATURA

The Swiss Matura examination is open to all persons who

- submit the registration papers duly completed and accompanied by the required enclosures,
- who have paid the registration and examination fees sent with the registration confirmation,
- are at least 18 years of age in the year in which they take the 2nd part or the overall examination.

The examinations are offered by the Swiss Maturity Commission and organized by the State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation. Two examinations are held annually in each of the three language regions. The examinations consist of several written and oral parts.
